Taos High 4 Year Summary

The UNM-Taos Title V College and Career Prep Program continues to expand its services in terms of the number of students assisted as well as the number of services provided by Title V Cooperative grant. The program has also enhanced its services by including ACT test preparation for juniors and seniors, 9th grade activities, and a Native American initiative. This current year includes a series of talking circles with the entire 7th grade class of 110 students at Taos Middle school.

In the 2009-2010 school year the UNM-Taos College and Career Prep Program assisted a total of 181 Taos High School seniors, more than a 12% increase over the previous year. In meeting performance objectives, the percentage of students that participated in the program that attended postsecondary education increased to 76%. It should be noted that this exceeds by more than double the statewide rate of 35%.

In its second year, the Native American Initiative focused on helping 19 Taos Pueblo students complete high school with a majority enrolling in higher education. It should be noted that the Taos Pueblo Education and Training Department pays for half of the Native American program personnel.

In preparation for institutionalizing and resourcing its important and successful activities at Taos High and now Taos Middle school, the College and Career Prep Program will enter into discussions with the Taos school district on assigning values to its activities (attached). In its final year of funding, the Title V Cooperative grant through its College and Career Prep Program continues to enhance and improve services to students and with financial assistance looks forward to expanding services to students even further in the coming years.

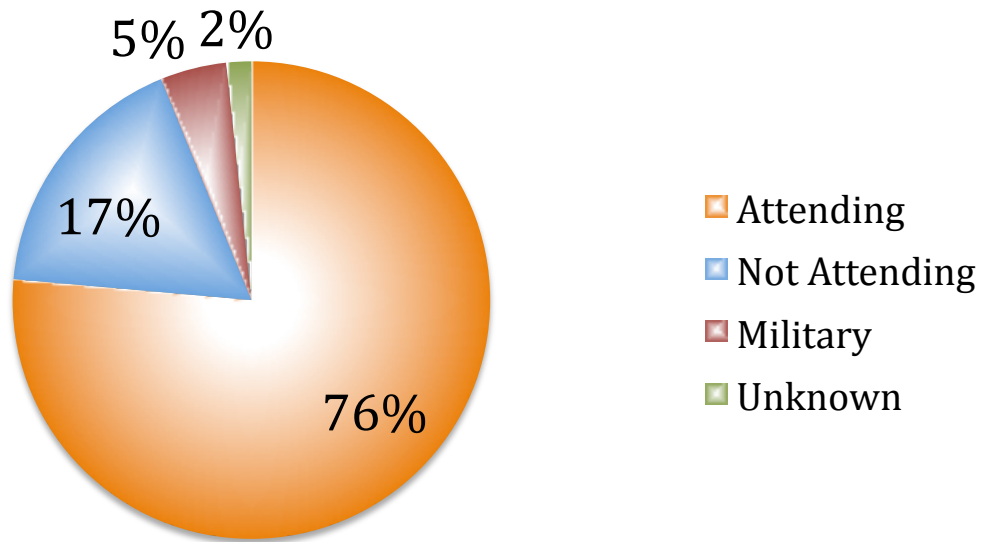

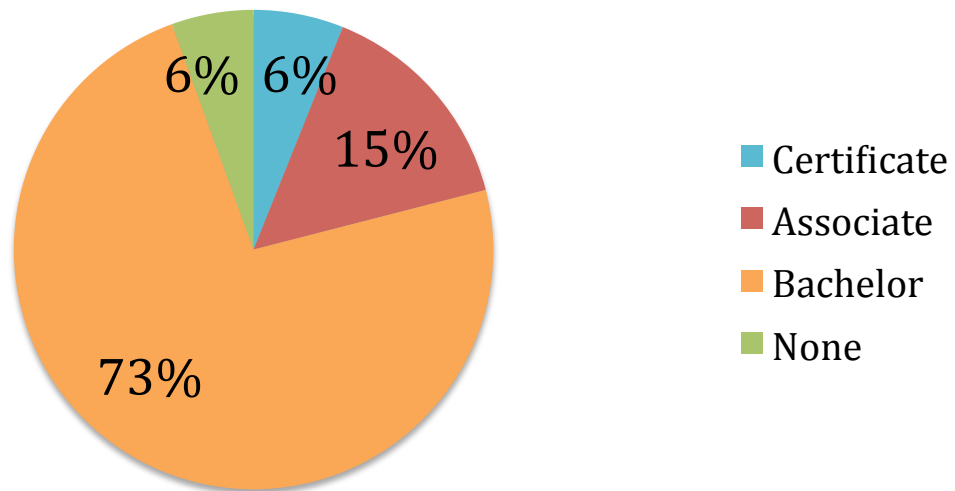

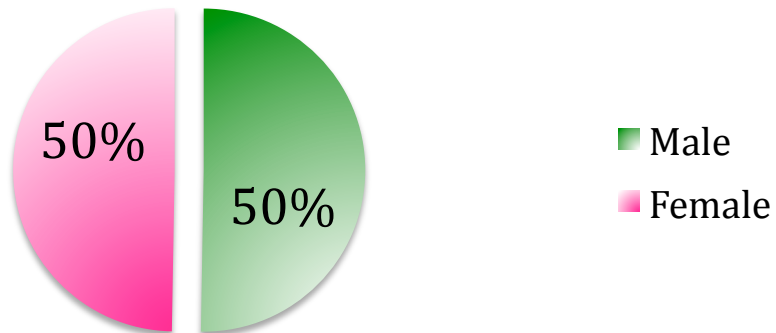

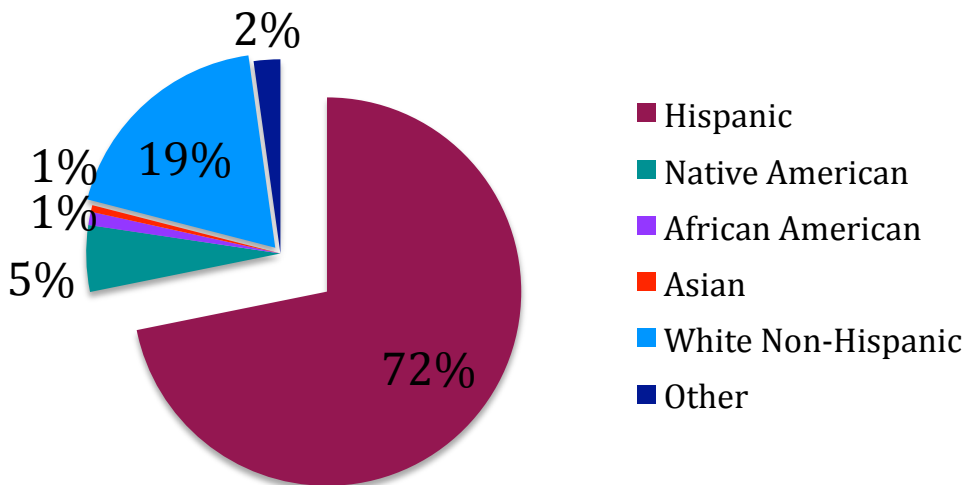
Degree of Interest-Taos
