

## University of New Mexico Development Funds

The Title V Developing Institutions Grant received by UNM-Taos for the FY02 (the current year) through FY06, includes monies for faculty development activities. While the use of some of these funds will be designated by the institution, others are to be made available to faculty members on a request basis. Guidelines for these requests are as follows:

1. The total amount of Title V funds available for faculty development activities are \$15,000.
2. Travel funds may be requested for any reasonable faculty development activity. Individual faculty may request up to \$500 for travel expenses. Requests should be accompanied by a brief (one or two paragraph) description of the activity. Funds will be awarded for the annual period beginning October 1, 2001.
3. Professional development funds priorities are improved pedagogy, instructional methodologies, advising, or outcomes assessment, as stipulated in the Title V grant. Individual faculty may request up to \$750 for registration, travel and expenses to conferences, workshops, etc. for such activities. Requests should be accompanied by a brief (one or two paragraph) description of the activity. Funds will be awarded for the annual period beginning October 1, 2001.
4. Faculty who receive professional development funds from these Title V allocations are expected to provide a written report of the activity upon its completion. The purpose is not to document attendance, but to contribute to a knowledge base of pedagogical information for faculty colleagues at UNM-Taos.
