How do I get the software?

Go to lobomail.unm.edu and sign in with your UNM Net ID, then click on Outlook. You now have access to **Office 365**. To download this on a personal device, click on “Install Office” drop down and click “Office 365 apps”.

OneDrive cloud base data storage is located within the Office 365 applications.

Symantec End Point is an antivirus available for you by going to it.unm.edu/download and selecting your computer’s Operating System. Click on Antivirus and login with your Net ID. Once you log in, click “Proceed to Antivirus Download All Versions”. Follow the instructions on the screen, download and run the installer.

Adobe Creative Cloud offers a variety of digital media applications. Follow steps below to access.

- Browse to <https://creativecloud.adobe.com/cc/en>
- Select “Sign In” in the top right corner
- Enter your UNM email address, select continue
- Select “Company or School Account”
- Authenticate using your UNM email credentials
- Select “View All” to review the list of Apps available for download
