Step 1:

Admissions

What can I expect during this meeting?

Your Admissions Officer will:

- Assist you with the admissions application process.
 - Determine admissibility requirements based on program selection
 - Provide support in requesting official transcripts
 - Provide support in creating your student Net Id and Password and acquiring your Lobo ID Card

Step 2:

Financial Aid

What can I expect during this meeting?

Your Financial Aid Officer will:

- Assist with your FAFSA Application
- Review your file and inform you of documentation required
- Provide support in filling out verification documentation
- Answer any questions you may have about your financial aid, including:
 - Veterans Education Benefits
 - Work Study/Student Employment Opportunities

Step 3:

Placement

What can I expect during this meeting?

- The CASA staff will discuss your option for placement into Math and English.
