



Locating Textbooks

Find your Textbooks for your UNM Taos courses:

Go directly to <http://bookstore.mbsdirect.net/unmtaos.htm> or

1. Go to: taos.unm.edu.
2. Hover over **Student Services** on the right side of the menu bar.
3. Click on **Bookstore**.
4. Click on **Order Your Books**. (Note that there is an option for selling your books back.)
5. Decide how you would like to pay. Click **Continue** under chosen method. (***You are not obligated to purchase from this site and they do not ask for credit card information until the very end.***)
6. You can also determine the textbook information at this point to use for searching elsewhere; be sure to **get the ISBN number** to get the correct version of the book.

OTHER TEXTBOOK SOURCES, new and used

- UNM Taos **bulletin boards**: buy textbooks from fellow students
- **Social Media** e.g. ForSaleTaos on Facebook
- **CASA** (Center for Academic Success and Achievement) – in house loaners
- UNM Taos **Library**: general collection, course reserves, ILL, ebooks – short term loans
- Google Books <https://books.google.com/>: full-text and partially digitized books

For students whose purchased textbooks have not yet arrived:

- **BlackBoard Learn** <https://learn.unm.edu/>: Some instructors post pdf files of the first few chapters
- **UNM Taos Library** <http://taos.unm.edu/library/>:
 - **Course Reserves**: Includes instructors' personal copies of textbooks and supplemental sources and titles from the General Collection. Usually for use in the library, but chapters can be copied. In some cases, the first few chapters have been copied already. Check **WorldCat Course Reserves** for titles.
 - **General Collection**: While the Library does not have the space to carry all textbooks, most of the core classes are represented. Checkout is 2 weeks, with a 2-week renewal if no one has the title on hold.
 - **E-book collection**: check **WorldCat** for e-books that can be read online or downloaded. When you are off-campus you will need your UNM ID to access the book.
 - **Interlibrary Loan (ILL)**: materials can be borrowed from other library systems. Plan for a 3-to-10-day wait. Due dates will depend on the lending library's requirements.
- **CASA (Center for Academic Success and Achievement)** :
 - **Virtual Bookshelf**, mostly Pearson titles. Amber Gordon or the Library can log you in. Pages can be printed, but the site limits to 5 pages at a time.
 - Some textbooks are purchased **for use in CASA**.
 - Some **chapters** have been copied and can be borrowed from the CASA front desk.
