UNM-T CNA Immunization Requirements:

The following documentation is required two weeks prior to the first day of clinical to attend the course's clinical section. If they are not completed, entrance into the clinical area will not be permitted. All course fees will be forfeited, and the student will not be able to pass the course.

All documents (immunization records, receipts) must be brought to the Ras O'Donnell Allied Health Program Specialist. Please set an appointment by emailing rodonnell@unm.edu.

Immunizations:

	Measles/mumps/rubella (M/M/R) – 2 dose series
	Hepatitis B Series- series of three (3), documentation of start of series at minimum.
□ comp	Hepatitis B Titer to confirm immunity if hepatitis B series has been leted
	Tdap 1 (tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis)- one (1) within the last 10 years
	Varicella [chickenpox/shingles] either documented proof of having 'chicken pox' with a titer [blood test] to confirm immunity or 2 dose varicella vaccination
	COVID -19 vaccination, documentation of the start of the of series per manufacturer with booster
	Influenza (flu)- seasonal immunization for clinical during October-April months
	Tuberculosis: <u>annual</u> titer [blood test] or PPD (negative for <u>two consecutive</u> years) or Two- Step PPD
