Program Description

The Phlebotomy Technician Program prepares students to provide safe, ethical, and professional blood collection services across diverse healthcare settings. Students develop foundational knowledge, technical proficiency, and professional communication skills necessary to perform venipuncture and capillary puncture procedures, maintain infection control standards, and ensure accurate specimen handling, labeling, and processing. This program addresses the growing need for qualified phlebotomy professionals in hospitals, clinics, and laboratories, while providing a pathway for career advancement in the healthcare field. Upon successful completion, students are eligible to sit for national certification exams and have the opportunity to continue their education toward a UNM-Taos Medical Assistant Certificate or other allied health credentials.

Admissions Requirements

- Students must be 18 years of age
- Meet current minimum qualifications for English comprehension assessment (provided by UNM-Taos)
- Caregiver background screening
- Drug screen
- Meet with Allied Health Program Specialist to support academic planning and success in the program
